Best Practice I - Sanatanam Teaching Learning Centre

Title: “Sanatanam Teaching Learning Centre”

Objectives:

1. To ensure the effective implementation of outcome-based education through faculty and student training.
2. To enable the creation and dissemination of new knowledge/expertise by promoting research.
3. To ensure the readiness of students for employment and entrepreneurship.

The Context:

In this post-pandemic era, more than ever, the world is experiencing a heightened need for good educational leadership. Switching between offline and online modes of education, inaccessibility to learning resources and the lack of social interaction have badly affected student communities. Faculty members are forced to experiment with novel techniques to ensure learning. In this context of hurdles and new opportunities, Sanatana Dharma College has geared up to lead the way, through the inception of the Sanatanam Teaching Learning Centre.

The Practice:

The Sanatanam Teaching Learning Centre aims to provide quality inputs to faculty and students in higher education, in the form of Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs), Student Development Programmes (SDPs), seminars, symposia and other academic activities. Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs) under the TLC will focus on blended teaching-learning practices, curriculum designing, innovative classroom techniques, research methodology and the use of ICT in academics and research. The Student Development Programmes (SDPs) will focus on optimal use of e-resources, study skill development, use of ICT in higher education, employability skills and English for Academic Purposes. The teaching learning centre also seeks to organize seminars, symposia, workshops and other related activities that will ensure the exchange of knowledge and research insights.

Evidence of Success:

Faculty Development Programme on use of Microsoft Excel titled “Excel for Beginners”, FDP on the “Essence and Essentials of Teaching” and a two-day FDP and Induction Programme for newly recruited faculty members were organized under the aegis of Sanatanam Teaching Learning Centre. The FDPs proved to be immensely successful. More programmes for students and teachers will be organized by the TLC in future.

 - >By offering value added talks, workshops and skill enhancement sessions to students.

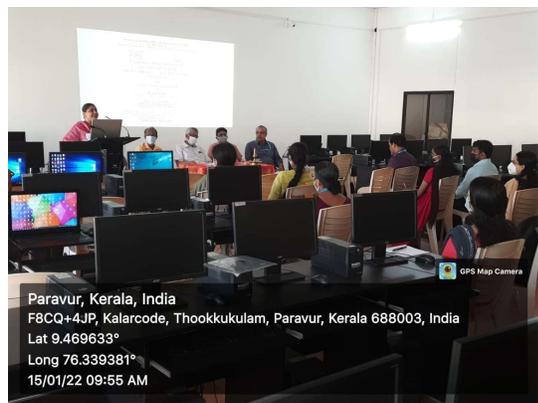
2. To enable the creation and dissemination of new knowledge/expertise:

- >By creating an ecosystem for entrepreneurship development.

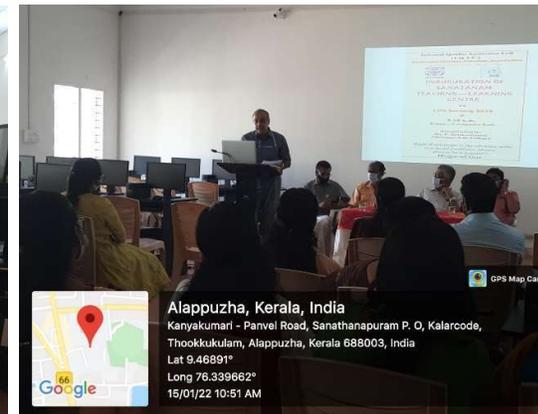
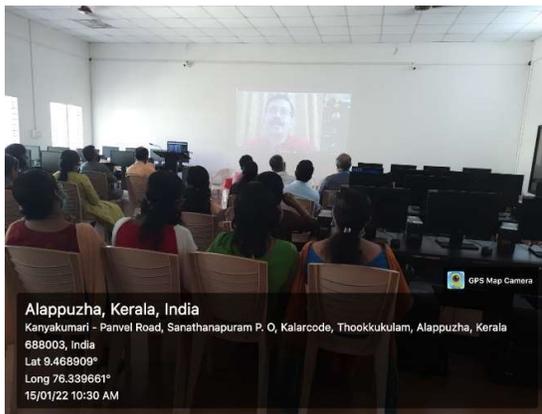

Best Practice II – Implementation of MIS/ERP (Management Information System)

Title: “Implementation of MIS/ERP”

Objectives:

1. To enable the effective collection, processing and storage of information pertaining to students, faculty and the college office.
2. To help in the easy retrieval and dissemination of information for various processes of decision making.
3. To automatize the processes of data collection and exchange between various departments/offices.

The Context:

Effective collection, processing, storage and retrieval of data are essential for decision making and effective management in an educational institution. Higher education institutions in particular, require systems for data storage and dissemination to stakeholders. Student admission, attendance, tests and other activities require to be done through an effective system. Teachers’ work schedules also require systematic treatment. Higher education institutions have therefore been adopting MIS. NAAC peer team that visited S.D.College in the third cycle suggested the implementation of an MIS. It is in this context that the institution decided to implement “Campus Genie” MIS.

The Practice:

A trial run of Campus Genie MIS Platform started at S.D.College on 5 May, 2021 as per the recommendation of IQAC followed by approval by the College Council. An Orientation Programme for the usage of Campus Genie was given through GoogleMeet on 27 May 2021. Detailed guidelines for the usage of the platform were given in this session. IQAC requested faculty members to use the platform and give their feedback on changes required. The full fledged implementation of “Campus Genie” MIS was done the following academic year. Campus Genie was adopted as the system for attendance marking and storage, exchange of notes, and the storage of internal marks.

Evidence of Success:

In the first week of August, IQAC collected feedback on the utility of Campus Genie MIS from faculty members using a google form. A total of 44 faculty members offered their feedback. The questions were meant to rate various features of the MIS on a 5 point scale. As per the feedback received, the user friendliness of the platform is rated as 3.98. The features rated highest (above 4) are the ease of attendance entry, accessibility of student scores to parents and the ease of report generation for various purposes. Faculty members also assert that the provision of saving study material on Campus Genie helps students access study materials at their convenience without

wasting storage space on their devices. Questions on lesson plan generation through MIS, 'Mingle' option and the provision for recording leave/OD details have received positive response from the faculty. In the section for open suggestions, faculty members observe that the MIS saves time and effort. Campus Genie acts as a one-step solution for data storage and data management in education; an improvement upon the 'work diary system.' It may be effectively utilized for all documentation purposes including the preparation of files for NAAC, NIRF etc.
